It goes without saying, that the faculty and staff at St. Paul Lutheran School have grown fond of your child(ren). We certainly look forward to seeing them again next year.


The school year starts on Wednesday, August 20th @ 8:15 AM. More information will be forthcoming about final enrollment procedures and
